## Please note the following:

- The deadline to submit applications for this workshop is **16 November 2018**.
- Each society is invited to submit the names of **two** candidates within their country who are responsible for training in gastroenterology, hepatology, endoscopy, or GI surgery.
- One candidate should hold a senior training position and the second candidate should either be responsible for training on a junior level or entering a training position.
- Candidates do not need to come from the same university or institute.
- Direct individual applications will not be accepted. Applications will only be accepted from official WGO Member Societies Representatives and Training Center Directors submitted digitally via this link: <a href="https://form.jotform.com/82684716401155">https://form.jotform.com/82684716401155</a> by **16 November 2018**.
- Priority will be given to WGO member societies that have paid their dues through 2018.

## TTT applicants must fulfill the following criteria:

- **Fluency in English** is required as not only are the lectures delivered in English, but the breakout sessions involve active participation and discussion from all members of the group.
- Participants attending the workshop must be responsible for training in their countries, within their own unit/region, and commit to putting the TTT workshop lessons into place upon return to their own teaching environment.
- Participants are responsible for obtaining their own medical insurance while attending the workshop. WGO does not provide medical coverage for participants.
- Participants are required to attend the entire workshop and should plan to arrive on the specified arrival and departure dates listed above.
- Applications from WGO Member Societies will be reviewed for adherence to the above criteria and for the equal distribution of TTT workshop spots amongst member societies.
- Member societies are invited to cover the costs of travel for their candidates or to arrange other forms of support as WGO is not in a position to cover these costs.
- Single accommodation, ground transportation, catering and onsite expenses as well as all course materials are covered by the host society and WGO. A maximum of 5 night's accommodation is provided for each participant.
- Should participants wish to bring their partners with them to TTT they will be charged for the additional rooming costs along with social event and meal expenses.
- The participant acknowledges by registration, that he/she has no right to lodge damage claims against the organizers in the event of cancellation due to unexpected events / force majeure or changes to program due to any reason.
- The participant acknowledges by registration that the WGO and the host society are solely responsible for the organizing of Train the Trainers. Participants who wish to arrive before or depart after the specified arrival and departure days, must clarify their accommodations and other personal expenses which may occur (ground transportation, meals etc.) directly with the hotel.
